Purpose/Mission/Responsibilities:

- Provide funding for the Parish and Christ Church Day School plus for community, national and international philanthropic and evangelical projects
- Provide fellowship for workers, shoppers and donors
- Provide a place for resale of useable items

Major Accomplishments:

- The Thrift Shop supported numerous worthwhile ministries this year:
 - \$32,574 went to Christ Church Ministries
 - \$32,500 went to Diocesan/National/International Outreach Ministries
 - \$ 1,000 went to the Thrift Shop's Christ Church Endowment Fund
 - \$ 7,000 went to savings for possible 2012 Christ Church Capital Campaign
- Provided fellowship for parishioner and non-parishioner volunteers
- Provided recycling for its donors
- Made gently-used items available for purchase at low cost
- Donated clothing, toiletries, books and other items to philanthropic organizations
- Hosted special events including Christmas Boutique and Progressive Dinner

Summary:

This was the Thrift Shop's best year ever with sales of just over \$86,000, an increase of more than \$10,000 over last year's record level. The Thrift Shop is a major outreach ministry which is managed and staffed all by volunteers. Their efforts provide support for a wide range of parish ministries as well as outreach efforts at the diocesan, national and international level.
